ABOUT THE FILM

In 2016, Jayson approached Ruckus Skye & Lane Skye to commission a short film script and they asked him, "What scares you the most?" Jayson replied "My parents growing old." Two weeks later they gave him the script for Chipper.

After years of attempting to produce the film, it was finally shot in June of 2022.

As the baby-boom generation ages, more and more members of Gen-Jones and Gen-X are finding themselves with parents in their final years. Everyone hopes their loved ones will have a full and long life that will end peacefully. But, as medical science continues to prolong life "at any cost", decisions about quality of life and the right to die start knocking on the door.

With Chipper, Jayson hopes to bring this not often discussed, due to social stigma and legality, dilemma into focus so that others confronted with these decisions will find they are not alone.

Until laws are changed, more and more people will slam into the wall our protagonist does in our film. We are not condoning his course of action but, what choice does Chipper have now?

Shaun MacLean


Director


Weird Brothers Productions
